We are again able to accept payment by bank transfer. Please use your surname as payment reference.

Please ensure you enclose the following items with your printed off **signed** renewal form:

- ▲ A cheque or postal order made payable to Henleaze Swimming Club if you are not transferring the money.
- A One recent passport size photo of each member with name on the back.
- A Proof of student status
- ▲ Small stamped self-addressed envelope so that we can send your card to you.
- Address the front of the envelope containing your application with CHQ if paying by cheque or TRS if paying by transfer, as shown below.

# **General Information**

Juniors (under 18 years on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2020) can only stay at the lake if they have successfully swum 50 metres at the lake and they must have their supervising adult with them at all times. Juniors between 13 and 18 years who have passed their test may stay at the lake unaccompanied by adults but they cannot bring guests. They can be members in their own right provided their parent or guardian has signed the disclaimer. **Please note that babies and any children under 18 yrs. are not allowed at the lake at any time unless they can swim 50 metres in the lake.** 

Guest fees: Seniors: £7 (£5 after 6pm) Juniors and concessions: £4 (£2 after 4pm) Senior members may bring a maximum of 2 guests to the lake and must always remain at the lake with them. Guests are signed in on the guest sheets and they must read the information shown to them about our safety procedures. Guests under 18 years must take the 50 metre swimming test on their first visit each year and for safety reasons cannot stay at the lake if they fail this test. Once successful this is recorded by the supervising superintendent and they do not have to retake the test on subsequent visits.

**Parking:** When entering and leaving the grounds please drive at walking pace and park sensibly at the lake and if the car park is full please park considerately on adjacent roads and not by the lake entrance. It is important we maintain good relationships with our neighbours so please park on one side only of Lake Road and not on the grass verges. We have plenty of bicycle racks for those who cycle.

**Club rules:** These are displayed at the lake and a copy can be found on the Club's website. Please ensure you abide by these. In particular please note that mobile phones must not be used on the lawns. They should only be used in the car park area.

**Clubroom:** There is a kettle, fridge and sink and microwave for your use in the Clubroom. You need to bring your own mug, tea, coffee, milk, etc. Please wash your own things and help keep the club room clean and tidy.

**Closing time:** Please be off the club premises by closing time and be out of the water 20 minutes before then.

Sauna: For those over 16 years only. This was reduced from 18 years in 2019 and will be reviewed prior to the start of the season

Lake Events on our Website: Keep up to date with events at the lake through our website and posters at the lake.
